Help the mentally and physically challenged in our community achieve independence and work skills through programs and services at Stepping Stones and MARC Workshop.

HEALTH: Make a difference by supporting programs that provide health services to our community.

Help these agencies continue to provide quality services and programs to those in need: Adult Day Care of Martinsville & Henry County, American Red Cross, Citizens Against Family Violence, and Mental Health Association.

Make sure everyone has access to emergency medical assistance through: Axton Life Saving Crew, Bassett Rescue Squad, Fieldale-Collinsville Vol. Rescue Squad, Horsepasture Vol. Rescue Squad, and Ridgeway District Rescue Squad.

Help young people to avoid risky behaviors and grow up to be healthy adults through prevention programs at Piedmont Community Services.
