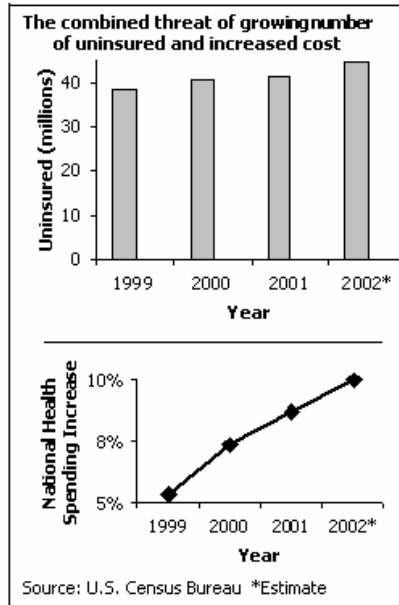

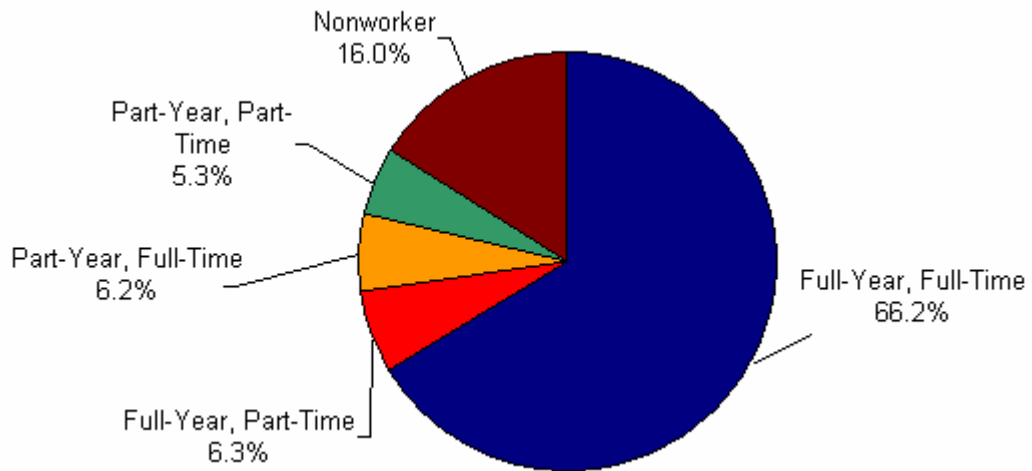

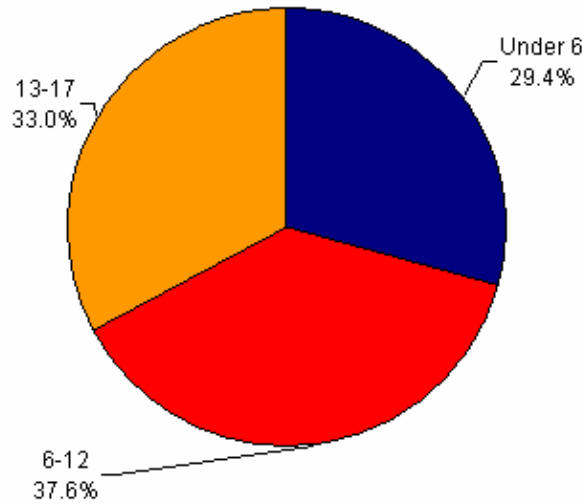

Percentage Uninsured Among Children by Work Status of the Family Head, 2004



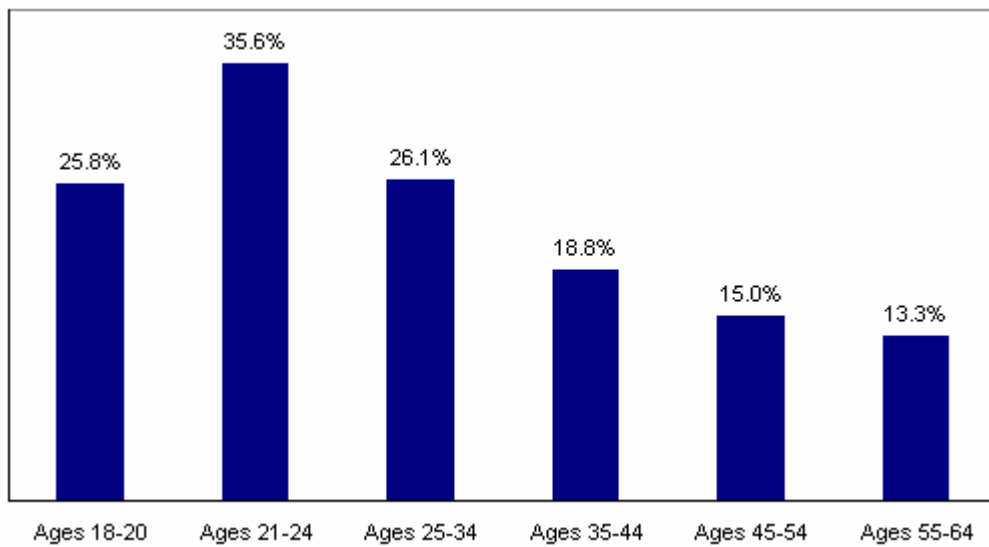

Uninsured Children by Age, 2004



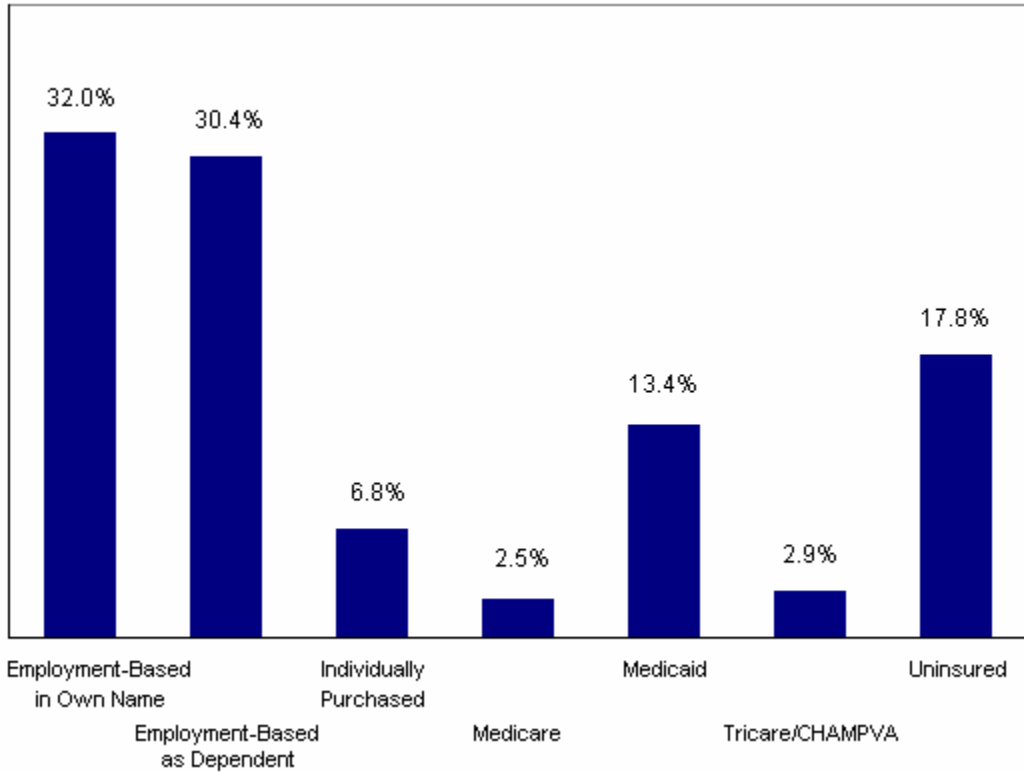

Percentage Uninsured Among Nonelderly Adults by Age, 2004



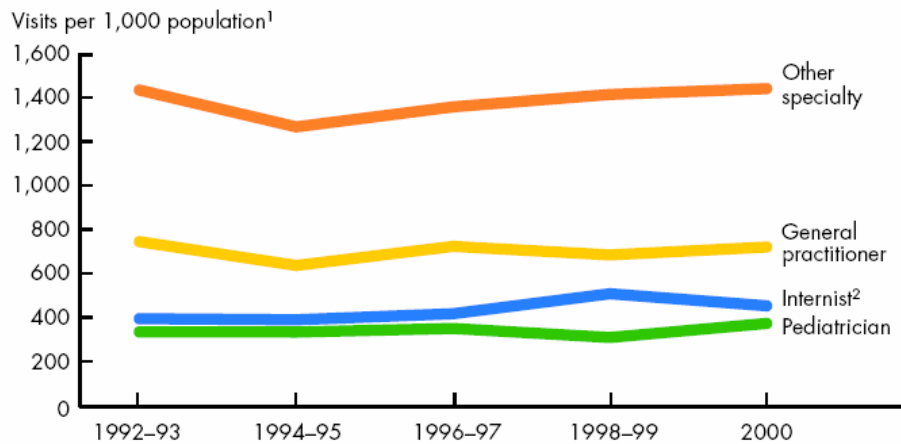

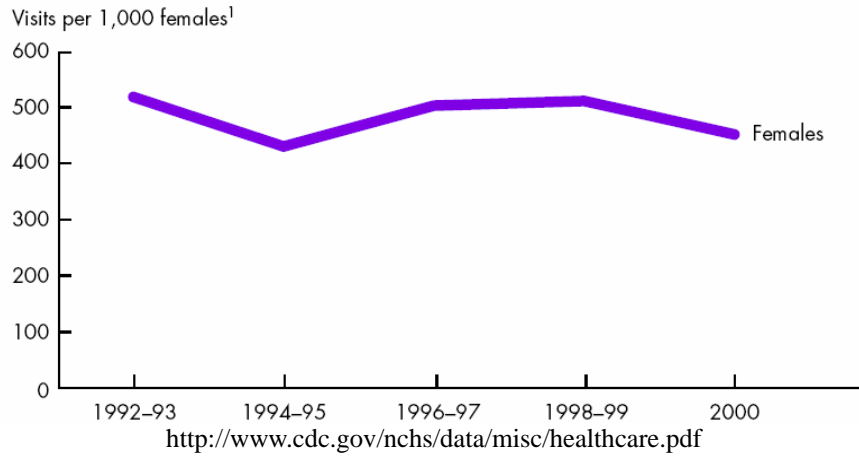
Chart 10A: Office visits to primary care and specialty physicians: United States, 1992-2000



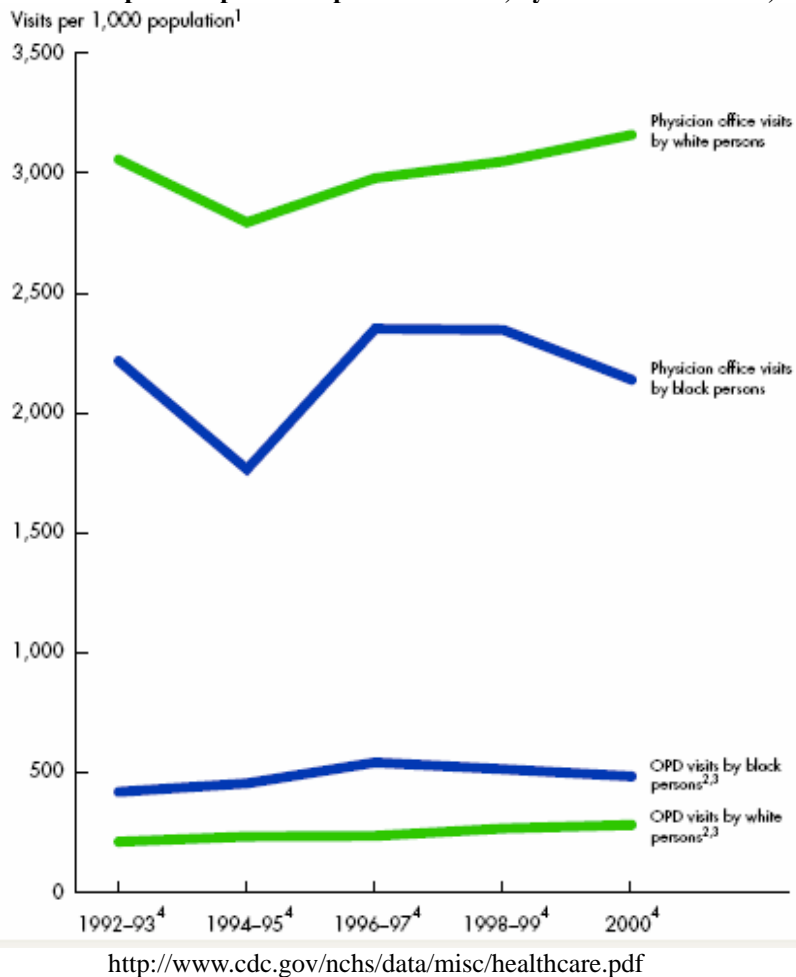

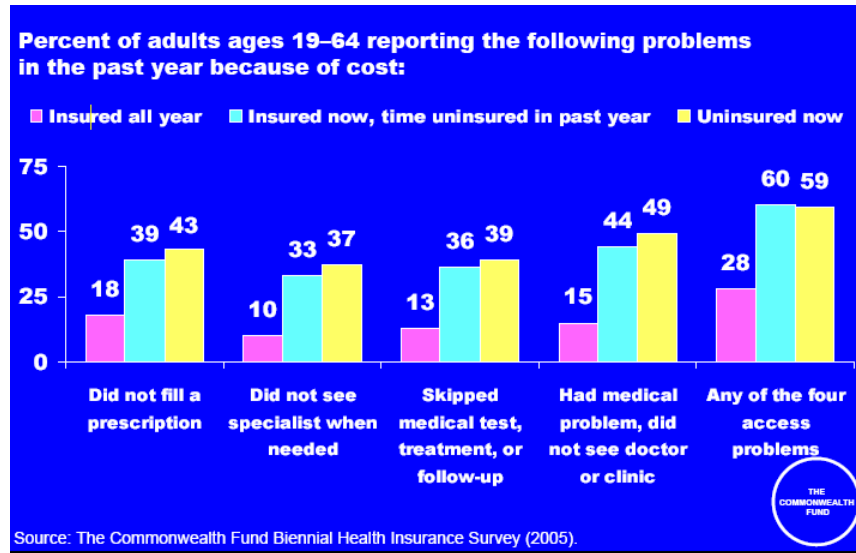

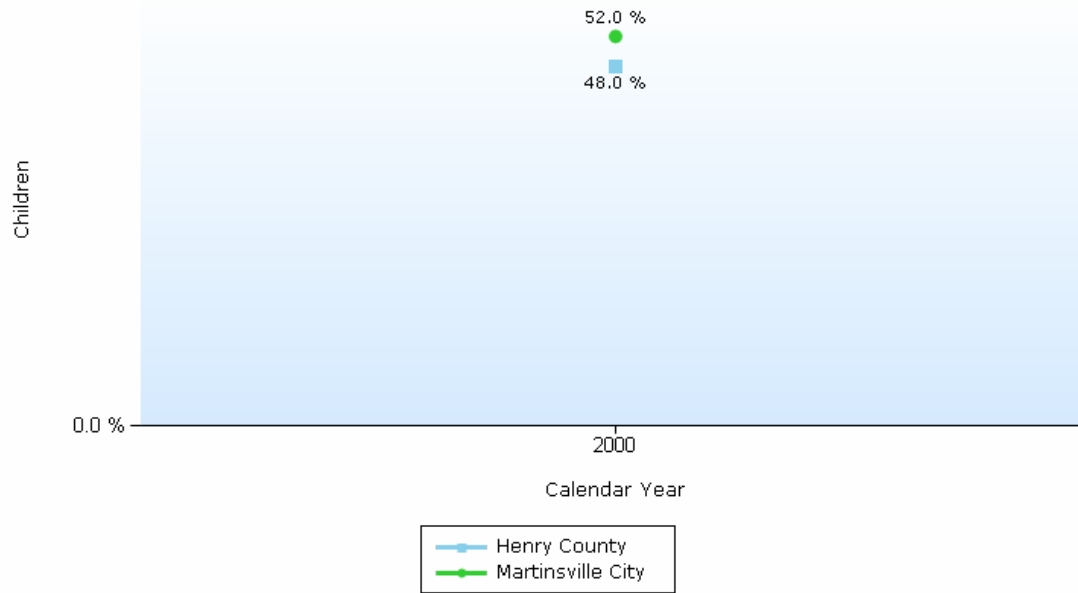
